Review/approve new contract with the New Lisbon Fire Dept – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to approve the new contract. Motion carried.

Review/approve new contract with the Mauston Fire Dept – Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve the new contract. Motion carried.

Review/approve new CSM for Frisk – After review it was found that there are existing buildings that don't meet the setback requirements. It was noted on the CSM that these buildings would be removed. Town Board decided that approval of the CSM would be done once the buildings were removed.

Review annual audit – Tabled until next month.

Approve 2023 Town Budget – Motion by Klinker, second by Wetley to approve the 2023 Town Budget. Motion carried.

Clerk's report – October bank statements and cash account balances as per general ledger were reviewed by the Board. Budget comparisons were made. Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to approve checks 7153-7167 as per disbursement journal. Motion carried.
